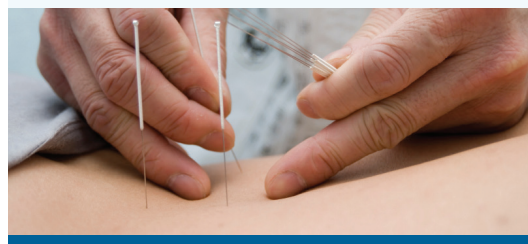
REASONS TO ATTEND:
